

## Greenfix Fixing Pins

Correct installation and fixing procedures are equally as important as the material selection.

Greenfix offers a comprehensive range of fixings that will cope with any problem and manufactures non-standard pins to cover any requirement.



### **FP200 - 200mm Steel Fixing Pins & FP300 - 300mm Steel Fixing Pins (500no or 100no box)**

200mm x 4mm diameter steel with ribbed shank for added grip and kinked head to stiffen and aid hammering in.

Best suited for firm soil such as clays. Will tolerate some small stones.

Our most widely supplied pin, covers most applications.

300mm x 4mm as above but for loamy or loose, stone free soils such as sand.



### **RS300 - 300mm x 8mm J Pins (50no box)**

A robust 8mm re-bar pin for hard stoney soils. The ribbing on the bar gives excellent grip and pull out resistance making this pin ideal for heavy duty for high loading applications.

Use with heavy blankets, meshes or grids.

300mm long with a 100mm head and 100mm return leg.



### **BP150 - 150mm Biostakes & BP100 - 100mm Biostakes (500no box)**

Made from a starch based material which is totally biodegradable within a few years.

Used to anchor erosion control blankets, mulch mat, turf, protective covers, and netting. Barbs along its body give greater holding force and prevents it being pushed out of the ground during ground-freezing conditions.

The 30 mm head is ideal for holding fabric firmly in place.



### **WP300 - 300mm Wooden Stakes (500no box)**

The large surface area and roughness of the natural pine creates a peg with excellent pull out resistance in soft loamy or sand soils.

The timber peg has such a high frictional interface with clay soil it is extremely difficult to pull out.

The 50mm timber dowel gives a large area for securing blankets, matting and meshes.
